BEAT HOLLOW

Sadler's Wells – Wemyss Bight (Dancing Brave)

BALLYLINCH STUD Fee €6,000 (1st Oct)

As recently announced in the Press, **Beat Hollow** has been acquired by Ballylinch Stud from Juddmonte Farms. The blue-blooded son of **Sadler's Wells** was a top class performer from eight to twelve furlongs, winning the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris, Gr.1 Arlington Million, Gr.1 Turf Classic and Gr.1 Manhattan Handicap, as well as being Gr.1-placed in the Derby, Eddie Read Handicap and Shadwell Turf Mile.

His dam won the Gr.1 Irish Oaks and has also produced a Gr.3 winner by **Caerleon**. He shares his grandam, the Gr.2-placed Listed winner **Bahamian (Mill Reef)**, with Gr.1 Pouliches heroine **Zenda**, the Champion racehorse and sire **Oasis Dream**, and the Group-winning stallion siblings **Martaline, Reefscape** and **Coastal Path**.

Beat Hollow has already proved himself in the stallion ranks, with his six crops to race on the flat having included twelve Stakes winners, headed by Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner **Proportional**, last season's Gr.2 winner **Sea Moon**, who was also placed in the Gr.1 St Leger and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf, and the unbeaten and improving **Beaten Up**. His progeny are also proving themselves over jumps and include the Gr.1-winning hurdler **Hollow Tree**, Gr.2-winning hurdler **Cinders And Ashes** (winner of his last three starts) and Aintree Gr.3 winner **Battle Group**, as well as triple winner **London Bridge** and the Irish-trained **Citizenship**.

DALGHAR

Anabaa – Daltawa (Miswaki)

HARAS DE SAINT ARNOULT Fee €4,000 (LF)

A half-brother to the European Champion racehorses **Daylami (Doyoun)** and **Dalakhani (Darshaan)**, both of whom have sired Classic winners, **Dalghar** is standing at stud for the first time this spring. At two, he ran second in the Gr.2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte after winning his maiden by three lengths over the same course, but was off the track until the end of October of his three-year-old season. Nevertheless, he still picked up a Listed victory at Deauville that December and comfortably won the 1400m Gr.3 Prix du Palais-Royal the following summer. Later that year he was also placed in the Gr.2 Lennox Stakes, Gr.2 Diadem Stakes, Gr.3 Prix du Pin and Gr.3 Prix de Seine-et-Oise. He retired as the winner of four races, showing the precocity to be a Group-placed winner at two, the speed to be a Gr.2 runner-up over 1200m and the stamina to win at Listed level over 1600m.

Besides his two best siblings, he is also a half-brother to the twice Gr.1-placed **Daymarti (Caerleon)** and, being by **Anabaa**, is bred on speedier lines than this trio. Their dam **Daltawa (Miswaki)**, a Listed-placed winner of three races, is the grandam of the Gr.3-winning filly **Daltaya** (also by **Anabaa**), and is a daughter of the Listed-placed **Damana**, a **Crystal Palace** half-sister to Listed winner and sire **Dastaan**.



DALGHAR

Half brother to **DALAKHANI** and **DAYLAMI**, by French Champion Sire **ANABAA**.

2nd in the Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte Gr.2 at 2, and winner at 4 of the Prix du Palais-Royal Gr.3 setting a new track record over 7 furlongs (1min17secs).

DICK TURPIN

Arakan – Merrily (Sharrood)

THE NATIONAL STUD Fee **£7,000** (1st Oct)


Dick Turpin, who will be standing for the first time this spring, raced consistently and with great success for the past three seasons, retiring with earnings not much short of £1m – a great reward to connections, as he had cost just €26,000 as a yearling.

A Gr.2 and sales race winner of four races at two, he beat stablemate **Canford Cliffs** on his debut at three in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes before second places in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes. A deserved Gr.1 win followed in the Prix Jean Prat (by four lengths), and he ended 2010 one length behind **Goldikova** in the Gr.1 Prix de la Foret. A second Gr.1 victory came last year in the Premio Vittorio di Capua, along with Gr.2 wins at Sandown and Ascot. In all he won nine races, six of them Group contests, up to a mile.


From a speedy and precocious family, he is from the first crop by **Nureyev's** Group-winning son **Arakan**. His dam is a placed half-sister to the Gr.3-winning sprinter **Deep Finesse** and to the dams of the Group-winning juvenile **Halmahera** and Listed-winning sprinter **Rising Shadow**, while his grandam, a dual winner at two, is a half-sister to the dams of the Gr.3-winning sprinter **Premiere Cuvee** and Group winners and sires **River Falls** and **Monsieur Bond**.

EASTERN ANTHEM

Singspiel – Kazzia (Zinaad)

WITHYSLADE FARM Fee **£2,000** (1st Oct SLF)

At stud for the first time in 2012, **Eastern Anthem** retired with earnings of £2.4m from his five wins and seven places in 16 starts. He won his only race at two, and was Listed-placed twice at three and again at four. He came into his own at Nad Al Sheba in early 2009, winning two valuable handicaps over ten and twelve furlongs before beating 14 rivals in a terrific finish to the Gr.1 Dubai Sheema Classic. Later that year he was placed in all three of Germany's all-aged Gr.1s over 2400m, including a short-head second in the Preis von Europa.

Surprisingly, given his sire's fine record at stud, he is the only son of **Singspiel** standing in Britain. He is the first foal out of **Kazzia (Zinaad)**, a Gr.3 winner in Italy at two who went on to win the 2002 Gr.1 1,000 Guineas and Gr.1 Oaks for Godolphin, as well as the Gr.1 Flower Bowl Stakes later that season. She is also the dam of his Gr.3-winning full-brother **Zeitoper** and a winner by **Monsun**. Her winning dam, **Khoruna (Lagunas)**, is also the dam of the multiple Listed winner **Kimbajar** and is out of a half-sister to the Gr.1 winner and sire **Kamiro**s. The fourth dam **Kandia**, was a Champion in Germany and her daughters have produced Group winner and sire **Kalatos** and the German Classic victrix **Kazoo**.

A €250,000 Goffs yearling purchase, Classic winner **Frozen Fire** was trained by Aidan O'Brien from two to four. He won on his debut in Ireland at two and was a head second on his three-year-old reappearance in the Gr.2 Dante Stakes behind the subsequent Gr.1 Derby runner-up **Tartan Bearer**. He finished down the field at Epsom but returned to action three weeks later in the Gr.1 Irish Derby, where he scored by a cosy two lengths, despite being involved in some of the bumping and scrimmaging at the furlong marker. His best race at four was when beaten about four lengths in the Gr.1 Coronation Cup and, after changing hands in August 2009 and moving to Mike de Kock, he had four starts at Meydan in early 2010.

By the top class racehorse and sire **Montjeu**, he is out of a winning half-sister to five black-type horses, including the Gr.2 German Classic victrix **Flamingo Road** (dam of the Gr.1-placed Gr.2 winner **Flamingo Fantasy**) and Gr.3 winner **Flamingo Paradise**. His second dam, by **Northern Dancer**, is a winning half-sister to US Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 CCA Oaks runner-up **Crowned** (dam of Gr.2 winner and sire **Best Of Luck**) and to dual US Gr.3 winner **Betty Lobelia**, out of the Stakes-placed **Exclusive Native** mare **Fair Rosalind**.

This is his first season at stud.

INDIAN HAVEN

Indian Ridge – Madame Dubois (Legend Of France)

WITHYSLADE FARM Fee £2,500 (1st Oct SLF)

Indian Haven won easily on his juvenile debut at Yarmouth, though his best run that year was his fifth in the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes. He also started his second season with a win, in the Listed Free Handicap, but was unplaced in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, after being seriously hampered twice. He made amends in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas next time, quickening well on the soft ground and scoring by a length.

By Champion Sprinter **Indian Ridge**, he is a half-brother to the Gr.1-winning two-year-old and successful South African sire **Count Dubois**, and to the Listed-placed **Place De L'Opera**, dam of two Group winners by Indian Ridge. His dam was a dual Gr.2 winner and is a half-sister to the dam of Gr.2 winner and sire **Daggers Drawn**, and to the dam of the Classic-placed Gr.2 winner **Kite Wood**.

Indian Haven has sired two Group-winning two-year-olds, **Ashram** (Gr.3 Somerville Tattersall Stakes) and **Aspen Darlin** (Gr.3 Firth of Clyde Stakes and second in Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes), as well as the Gr.2 Railway Stakes runner-up **In Some Respect** (now running in Hong Kong as **Dragon Fighter**), plus last season's Royal Ascot Listed scorer **Beachfire** and Italian Listed winner **Tellovoi**. Three more Italian runners, **Su Contadori**, **Jet Set Woman** and **Super Indian**, have won 18 races to date between them.

HARAS DE SAINT VOIR Fee €2,500 (48hrs of live foal)

After three seasons at Wood Farm Stud, **Lucarno** is now standing at Haras de Saint Voir, who have been the leading French stud for breeding NH horses for the past three years and have previously stood leading NH stallions **Robin Des Champs**, **Sleeping Car**, **Saint Preuil** and **Royal Charter**.

Bred and still owned by George Strawbridge, he won the Gr.1 St Leger and Gr.2 Great Voltigeur Stakes at three, and the Gr.2 Princess of Wales's Stakes at four. He was also fourth in the Gr.1 Derby, ahead of the Gr.1 Irish Derby winner **Soldier Of Fortune**. His trainer John Gosden said of Lucarno: "He is a really, really good horse", while his jockey Jimmy Fortune commented: "He's a beautiful horse, very relaxed, a real professional and a true Gr.1 horse."

He is one of numerous Gr.1 winners by **Roberto** stallion **Dynaformer**, who is standing for \$150,000 and has also sired 282 Stakes winners, as well as the triple US Champion Chaser and five times Breeders' Cup Steeplechase winner **McDynamo**. Also out of the **Diesis** mare **Vignette**, he is one of three Stakes winners out of by the French Gr.3 winner **Be Exclusive (Be My Guest)**.

He has covered books of 93, 65 and 42 in his first three seasons at stud.

MISU BOND

Danehill Dancer – Hawala (Warning)

NORTON GROVE STUD Fee £1,500 (1st Oct)

Misu Bond was a progressive two-year-old in 2005, winning at Doncaster on his second outing before taking his chance in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes, though he was hampered and finished down the field, and he ended his first season when accounting for 23 rivals in the valuable Listed Two-Year-Old Trophy at Redcar. He started 2006 with another victory, holding on from subsequent dual Group winner **Jeremy** in Newmarket's Listed European Free Handicap, and was later placed in the Gr.3 Ballycorus Stakes, also over seven furlongs.

By **Danehill Dancer**, he is a full-brother to the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **Air Chief Marshal** and a half-brother to the dual Listed winner and Gr.3 runner-up **Slip Dance**. Their dam is a winning half-sister to Gr.3 winner **Afaf** and to Listed scorer **Zack Hall**, and the immediate family also includes Gr.1 winner and sire **Houmayoun**.

His first small crop of two-year-olds won six races between them last season, including triple winner **Pint Size** and dual scorer **Bop It**. Among his second crop, just turned two, is a three-parts-brother to the Gr.2-winning sprinter and sire **Monsieur Bond**, while his yearlings include a half-brother to the Listed-placed **Lady Royale** and a half-sister to the eight times winner **Magical Music**.

MYBOYCHARLIE

Danetime – Dulceata (Rousillon)

HARAS DU MEZERAY Fee €4,500 (1st oct)

Myboycharlie was one of the top two-year-olds of his generation in 2007. After winning on his debut at the Curragh, he returned there two weeks later for the Gr.3 Anglesey Stakes, in which he beat the subsequent eight times Graded Stakes winner **Tuscan Evening** by an impressive seven lengths, then had two lengths to spare over **Natagora** in the Gr.1 Prix Morny – she went on to win the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes and the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas. He met with defeat for the first time in the Gr.1 National Stakes, finishing third behind the dual Champion **New Approach** and multiple Gr.1 winner **Rio De La Plata**.

He is a son of the high class sprinter **Danetime** and is one of several young stallions by that short-lived Gr.1-placed **Danehill** sire. He is one of six winners by five different sires out of the **Rousillon** mare **Dulceata** and he shares his grandam, the Listed winner **Snowtop (Thatching)**, with Australian Gr.1 winner **Snowland**, Gr.2 winner **Portillo**, and four Listed scorers. His third dam **Icing (Prince Tenderfoot)** won the Fillies' Mile when it held Gr.3 status and later became the dam of Gr.1 winner and sire **Al Hareb**.

Formerly resident at The National Stud, he has a first crop of around 43 yearlings and covered a second book of 68 mares last year.

PRIME DEFENDER

Bertolini – Arian Da (Superlative)

HEDGEHOLME STUD Fee £1,750 (1st Oct)

Prime Defender retired after 57 runs over six seasons. He won eight races, at two, three, five, six and seven, from five furlongs (at two) to seven, and showed a marked preference for a fast surface. He won the first of his three Listed races in the Free Handicap of 2007 and, after finishing down the field in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, his second in Haydock's Sandy Lane Stakes. He beat 12 rivals to win Doncaster's Listed Cammidge Trophy in March 2009 and won the biggest race of his career, the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes, the following year, when he had the likes of **Showcasing** and **Starspangledbanner** behind him. He was also placed seven times in black-type company.

He is one of 14 Stakes winners by the Group-winning juvenile and Gr.1-placed sprinter **Bertolini (Danzig)**. He is out of the juvenile winner **Arian Da**, a daughter of the speedy **Superlative** and a half-sister to the Listed-placed **Northern Cache**. The next dam is a multiple winning full-sister to **Sprink**, a dual Graded Stakes winner at Belmont Park, and half-sister to US Stakes winner **Northwest Sky**.

The stud's Andrew Spalding said, "He is a top class sprinter by a stallion who has proved an excellent sire of two-year-olds and is from a very fast family. He should particularly appeal to breeders in the north as that is where he won many of his good races."

WHIPPER

Miesque's Son – Myth To Reality (Sadler's Wells)

HARAS DU MEZERAY Fee €7,500 (1st Oct SLF)

Whipper, a French Champion Miler, won Gr.1 races at Deauville at two, three and four, starting with a defeat of the unbeaten dual Group winner **Much Faster** in the Prix Morny. He stretched out to a mile to beat **Six Perfections** in the Prix Jacques Le Marois at three and accounted for Gr.1 winners including **Goodricke** and **Patavellian** in the Prix Maurice de Gheest over 1300m at four.

He is a three-parts-brother to the dual Champion filly **Divine Proportions** (by **Miesque's Son's** full-brother **Kingmambo** and dam of a Gr.3 winner with her first foal), and is a half-brother to Listed winner **Assos** and the Gr.3-placed **Mythical Kid**. His dam won three Listed races in France, his grandam is a Listed-placed full-sister to the dual Gr.1 Derby winner and top class sire **Shirley Heights**, and his winning third dam is also the ancestress of Gr.1 winners **Pentire**, **Konigstiger** and **Markham**.

The Gr.3-winning juvenile **Dolled Up** came from Whipper's first crop, as did the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Hong Kong Mile runner-up **Royal Bench**. He sired 11 Stakes horses in Europe last season, headed by the Gr.2-winning sprinter **Wizz Kid** and Gr.3 winner **Topeka**, who was successful in her last four runs at two. His 2011 yearlings were headed by fillies sold for €72,000 and €70,000 (from the family of **Danedream**) at Arqana.

WOOTTON BASSETT

Iffraaj – Balladonia (Primo Dominie)

HARAS D'ETREHAM Fee €6,000 (LF)


Retired to stud in France where he collected his biggest victory, **Wootton Bassett** was France's Champion juvenile of 2010 and the joint third best in Europe (World Rankings). He was unbeaten that year, when his five victories included the valuable DBS Premier Yearling Stakes and Weatherbys Insurance £300,000 2-Y-O Stakes, and he wound up his first season in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere on Arc day. Making almost all, he had his rivals in trouble in the closing stages and won by two and a half lengths, with subsequent Classic/Gr.1 winners **Tin Horse** and **Moonlight Cloud** behind him. Matters did not go as planned last season, but he had four runs in Gr.1 company and finished a respectable fifth in both the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest.

He is a first crop son of the triple seven-furlong Gr.2 winner **Iffraaj (Zafonic)** and is the best of his sire's record 38 first crop juvenile winners. His dam was twice Listed-placed over ten furlongs, despite being by the sprinter **Primo Dominie**, and is also the dam of the Listed-placed juvenile **Mister Hardy** and grandam of **Katla**, a six-furlong Listed winner at two and three. His grandam, by **Chief's Crown**, is a winning half-sister to Gr.3 winner **Clare Bridge** (dam of two Group winners), and the family also includes Gr.1 winners **Silver Patriarch** and **Papineau**.
